

A BASIC GUIDE FOR YOUR SEE YOU AT THE POLE™

(This is intended to be only a simple guide. Be creative. Do whatever your group is led to do.)

The 2025 theme verse for *See You at the Pole*™ is Habakkuk 3:2 (NLT):

*"I have heard all about you, **Lord. I am filled with awe** by your amazing works.
In this time of our deep need, help us again as you did in years gone by.
And in your anger, remember your mercy."*

The book of Habakkuk opens with a prayer, where the prophet begins by pleading with God to act in the present like he has in the past, bringing down corrupt nations. Even when the world seemed to be falling apart, Habakkuk chose to trust and take joy in the covenant promise of God. In the same way, we can put our faith and hope in God and know that He is in control.

Here are some things you can pray for:

1. Pray for students all over the world who are gathering in other nations. There are some who are in countries where they have little to no religious freedom. Many may be hungry with not enough to eat. Let's pray for all students gathered with us today around the globe.
2. Pray for our nation and government.
3. Pray for our school—administration and teachers. For God's blessing and wisdom over those who lead and teach us.
4. Pray for our families.
5. Pray for our friends.
6. Pray for those in the prayer circle with you.

Pray that God will use SYATP to build up a core of students whose purpose will be to share the Gospel with non-Christian friends on campus. Ask God to bring spiritual awakening to His church.
